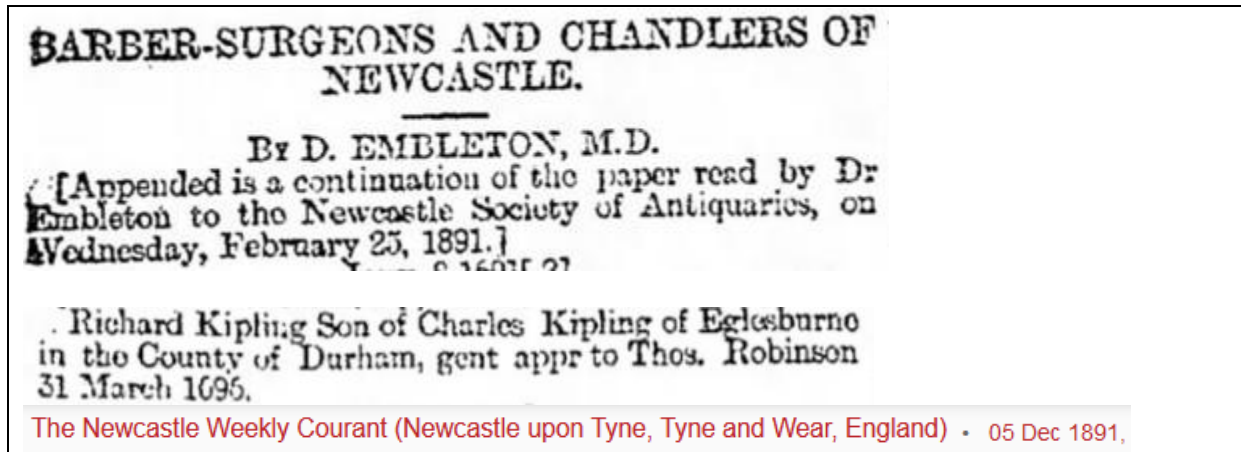


Richard Kipling, barber-surgeon

Richard Kipling was a son of Charles Kipling of Eggesburne in Middleton-in-Teesdale (see [The Kiplings of Middleton-in-Teesdale](#)). He was apprenticed to a Gateshead barber-surgeon in 1695, becoming free in 1703.



He received his freedom in 1703.

He married in 1707.

In 1712 and again in 1720, Richard took on apprentices of his own.

Richard married again in 1713.

In 1719, he was appointed a trustee (and stood surety for) for the execution of the will of Stephen Sofloe, joiner, of Gateshead [DPR/I/1/1719/S2/1-2]

I, Richard Kipling do hereby certify that the said
will was executed in the presence of the said
Richard Kipling and the said Stephen Sofloe

In 1724, he was named in the will of Newcastle barber-surgeon Thomas Robinson, who had been his apprentice-master:

DPR/I/1/1724/R13

To be LETT or SOLD,
A Large House, with a good Shop and Cellaring in Gateshead, near Pipewell-gate; Part of it now in the Possession of Mr. Richard Kipling, Surgeon. They may go to Mr. Mark Browell Attorney at Law in Newcastle, and he will treat with them about the same.

Newcastle Courant - Saturday 02 December 1727

In 1727, Eden's aunt, Margery Kirton, left land and a fishery at Norham, an exclave of County Durham on the Tweed, to her great-niece Margery, and £100 to Eden should she outlive Richard (which she did) [DPR/I/1/1731/K4/1]. Richard was surety for the execution of Margery Kirton's will and of that of her late husband, Anthony, vicar of Norham.

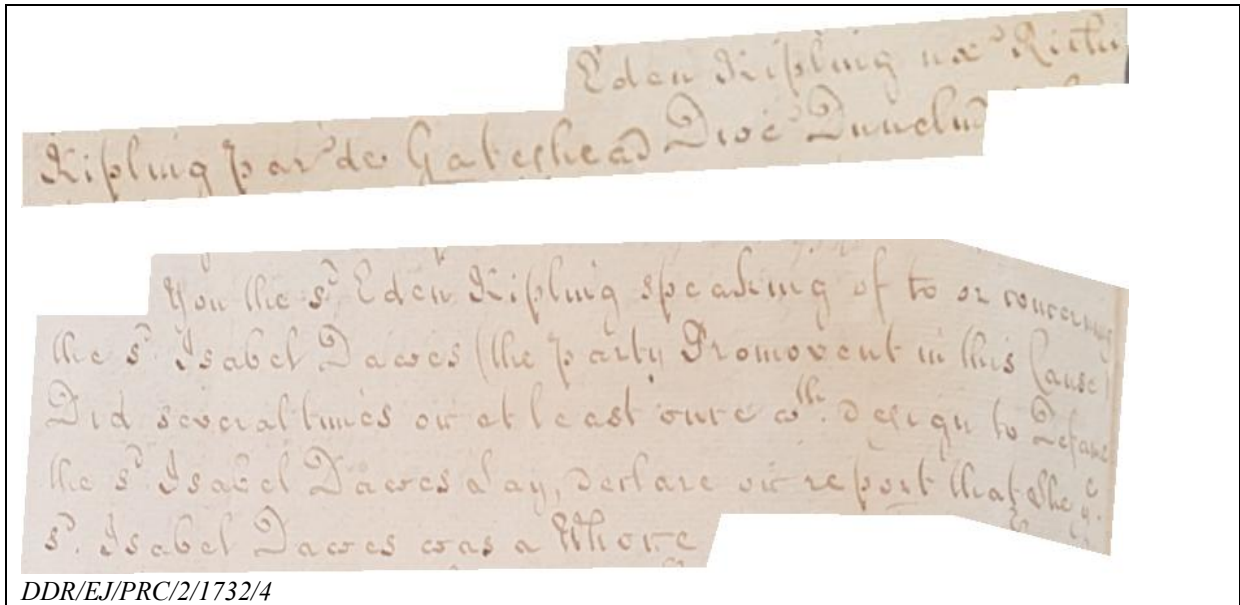

The same year, Richard ('barber-surgeon') was mentioned in the will of Isaac Heron of Newcastle, shoemaker, as one of the tenants of a property in The Side in Newcastle.



In 1732, Eden was accused in the diocesan court of defamation against an Isabel Dawes. The outcome is not known.



Daughter Jane married in 1733, Margery in 1734 and Hannah in 1741.

[Note: married 10 Aug at St. Andrew]

10 Apr 1741 Thomas Proctor (master-mariner), age 35, of Gateshead obtained a licence to marry Hannah Kipling, age 34, of Gateshead, directed to Gateshead or All Saints, Newcastle-upon-Tyne

Surety: Benjamin Ord, merchant, of Gateshead

[Note: married 13 Apr at Gateshead]

In 1736, Richard witnessed the will of mariner, William Hall of Gateshead.

DPR/1/1739/H3/1-2

In September 1742, Richard and Robert Chambers, dyer, acquired as trustees three pieces of copyhold land in Sedgfield from Richard's son-in law Benjamin Ord (who died later that year, having inherited property from his father, also Benjamin Ord, in 1740). The surrenders of the leases were recorded (DHC2/M2/417-9). They consisted of 3a of land in Ryall Field, 6a forming part of land known as the Noble Rent and a close of one oxgang called East End Close.

The same year, he was mentioned in the will of William Hall of Longbenton, gentleman, as co-tenant (with Peter Forster, see below) of a messuage co-owned by Hall in Gateshead [DPR/I/1/1742/D5/1-2].

In 1744, he was mentioned in the will of John Sisson of Newcastle, excise officer, as being co-tenant of The Half Moon in Newcastle: he also witnessed the will.

In 1745, he was surety for the administration of the will of Peter Forster of Gateshead, boat builder (see above).

In 1759 Thomas Fothergill, having served seven years with Richard Kipling, an apothecary of Newcastle upon Tyne, was made free of the Society of Apothecaries of London by redemption with a fine of £11 4s.⁸⁰







In 1761, a further surrender of the Sedgefield properties was noted, which commented that Jane Ord and Hannah Proctor were the heirs of Richard.
